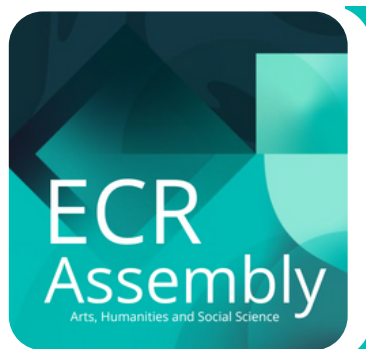

What will the School Representatives have to do?

Responsibilities:

- maintain channels of consultation with the ECR LIFE Officers and wider Assembly
- organise and host events for the AHSS ECR Community
- attend termly meetings of Council with a standing item will be included at each to raise issues or questions arising from the Assembly
- attend termly meetings of Research Strategy Group

Benefits:

- network with colleagues and build community awareness
- engage with senior PIs across AHSS subject areas
- develop skills in advocacy and an understanding of organisational planning
- reimbursement for time commitment of 6 days a year, plus holiday pay pro-rata, which can be used to support professional development or research expenses
- budget of £2000 to organise events and development projects for the AHSS ECR community

What will ECR LIFE Officers have to do?

Responsibilities:

- engage with their ECR communities, School Representatives and wider ECR Assembly through events, discussions and the Teams channel
- convene meetings with their communities, distil priorities and viewpoints, and feed these back to the School Representatives and wider ECR Assembly
- time commitment would be around 8 hours per term to include organising, convening, reporting and engaging

Benefits:

- apply for up to £600 towards professional development costs from the Enhancing Research Culture Fund
- manage a further allowance of £100 per term to sponsor ECR community building and event convening for their area
